



- Prune fruit bushes & trees and feed
- Plant any new bare root trees if not done in Jan
- Sow leeks in trays (greenhouse)
- Sow Aubergine (then keep warm)
- Chit potatoes
- Rabbit hunt!
- Tidy up



- Sow various crops in trays (greenhouse) – see guide list
- Spray or remove troublesome or difficult to access weeds
- Prepare watering system
- Mark tools and gazebo
- Farmers Market Sat 23rd – prepare & crew the stall



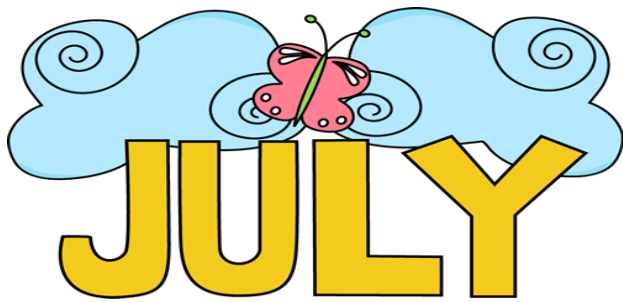
- Sow various crops in trays (greenhouse) – see guide list
- Pot on seedlings (& harden off) as required
- Prepare & sow part of carrot bed and beetroot
- Direct sow any hardy seeds if beds warm enough (7°C)
- Prepare & plant potato bed
- Farmers Market Sat 27th – prepare & crew the stall



- Prepare & sow remaining carrot bed
- Prepare & sow parsnip bed
- Pot on seedlings (& harden off) as required
- Plant out ready seedlings
- Direct sow seeds as necessary
- Prepare beds for other ready seedlings
- Build cage & net for peas
- Erect supports for beans
- Net strawberries against birds
- Start harvesting
- Farmers Market Sat 25th – prepare & crew the stall



- Water fruit bushes and new trees
- Plant out ready seedlings
- Net fruit bushes against birds
- Farmers Market Sat 22nd – prepare & crew the stall



- Water fruit bushes and new trees
- Direct sow late seeds
- Farmers Market Sat 27th – prepare & crew the stall



- Prepare wildflower area beneath new fruit trees (spray / hoe)
- Water fruit bushes and new trees
- Net fruit against birds
- Farmers Market Sat 24th – prepare & crew the stall



- Sow wildflower / grass mix (20:80)
- Heritage Day Sat 14th – major effort, garden quiz trail (Annette), stall (tombola?) etc – all hands on deck
- Farmers Market Sat 28th – prepare & crew the stall



- Dismantle watering system
- Start to protect any outdoor crops against early frost (fleece, cloches)
- Find a home for pumpkins
- Farmers Market Sat 26th – prepare & crew the stall



- Farmers Market Sat 23rd – prepare & crew the stall

- Prepare and plant onion beds
- Plant new bare root trees/bushes
